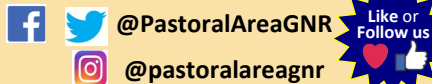

EASING OF COVID RESTRICTIONS

- Phased return of Adoration Prayer in Garristown

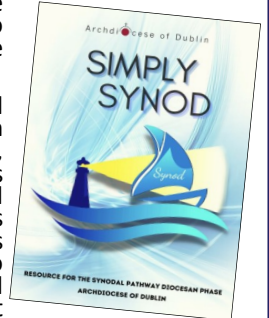
